STUDY TIP

SCRIPTURE

PRIMARY TEXT: 1 Corinthians 13

SUPPLEMENTAL TEXT:

Matthew 22:37-40, John 13:35, Romans 5:8, Romans 12:9, 1 Timothy 4:12, 1 John 4:7-21

OBSERVATIONS & APPLICATION

What words or phrases are repeated in this scripture?

Read John 13:35 and Romans 5:8. These verses show examples of "agape" love. Agape love is God's selfless and sacrificial love for us. When you read these verses, what do they tell you about how we should also love? Go to <u>StepBible.org</u> if you want to study the words in this passage or find more verses that talk about agape love.

Read 1 Corinthians 13:11 and 1 Timothy 4:12. What is the difference between physical maturity and spiritual maturity?

1 Timothy 4:12 tells us that our age doesn't define our spiritual maturity. Regardless of your age, in what areas do you need to spiritually mature?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7. Now re-read the passage and say Jesus' name in the place of love. Read it one more time saying your name in the place of love. Which of these actions is the hardest for you?

1 John 4:19 - We love because He first loved us. Examine yourself. Do you have a love for lost people?
