OBSERVATION AND APPLICATIONS

- Read 1 Kings 19:1-5a.
 - What factors could have been contributing to the way Elijah was feeling in verses 3 and 4? (For more context consider the events in 1 Kings 17 and 18)
 - Has there been a time in your life when you have felt this type of despair?
- Read 1 Kings 19:5b-9.
 - What does this passage reveal about God's character?
 - What response is required of us?

- Read 1 Kings 19:10-18.
 - Do you tend to look for God in the big signs or the small voice? (v.11-13)
 - How did God choose to speak to Elijah?
 - Considering God's response in verse 18, what is the significance of Elijah's response in verses 10 and 14?
- Read 1 Kings 19-21.
 - What is the significance of Elisha burning his work equipment?
 - What does obedience look like in your life?
