- How does Zacchaeus' story encourage us to embrace transformation through faith, even if it requires drastic changes in our lives?
- How can we, as salt and light, extend grace to others in a way that leads them toward positive change?

PRAYER

God, thank You for this picture of humility and dependence on Your grace to save us. Thank You for making a way so we are never too far gone. Thank You for how You see us. Lord, help us not get caught up in the crowd and the fear of man.
